On 18-19 June 2026, the Training of Trainers (TOT-2) was successfully conducted at the Amreli office for both Reel Marks and Regen programs. The training was facilitated by members of the CottonConnect team and expert resource persons, who delivered highly informative and engaging sessions.

Under the HRDD program, interviews and videography sessions were conducted with farmers and labourers to document their experiences and perspectives. A Focus Group Discussion (FGD) was also organized in Ambaliya village, where farmers and labourers actively participated in discussions on various social issues and labour rights.



Demonstration kits were distributed to the selected demonstration farmers, along with detailed guidance on their proper use and implementation.



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Reel Farmer Pool Program

During the month, Farmer Training Sessions 1 and 2 were successfully completed. A needs assessment covering 28 villages was also finalized.



Biochar application activities were carried out in farmers' fields and soil testing reports were distributed to participating farmers to inform them about agricultural practices.



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Gender Education

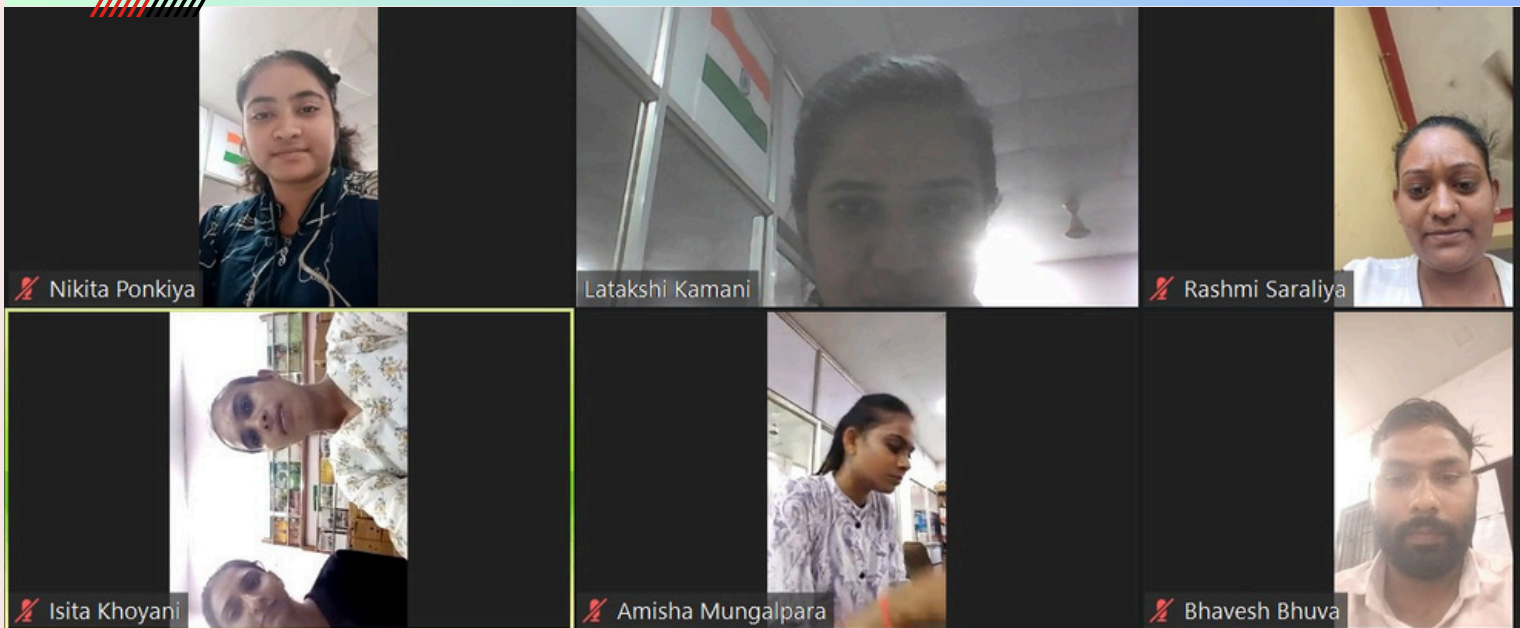
During the month, under the Gender Education Project, meetings were held with the principals of the high schools in Tataniya and Chakrava villages to discuss the implementation of the project. Home visits were also conducted with parents to introduce the organization and explain the objectives of the project.

During the session on 9 June, participants reviewed reports on the Gender Committee Meeting, Monthly Meeting and Well Monitoring. Team members also shared their key learnings and discussed the challenges encountered during implementation.



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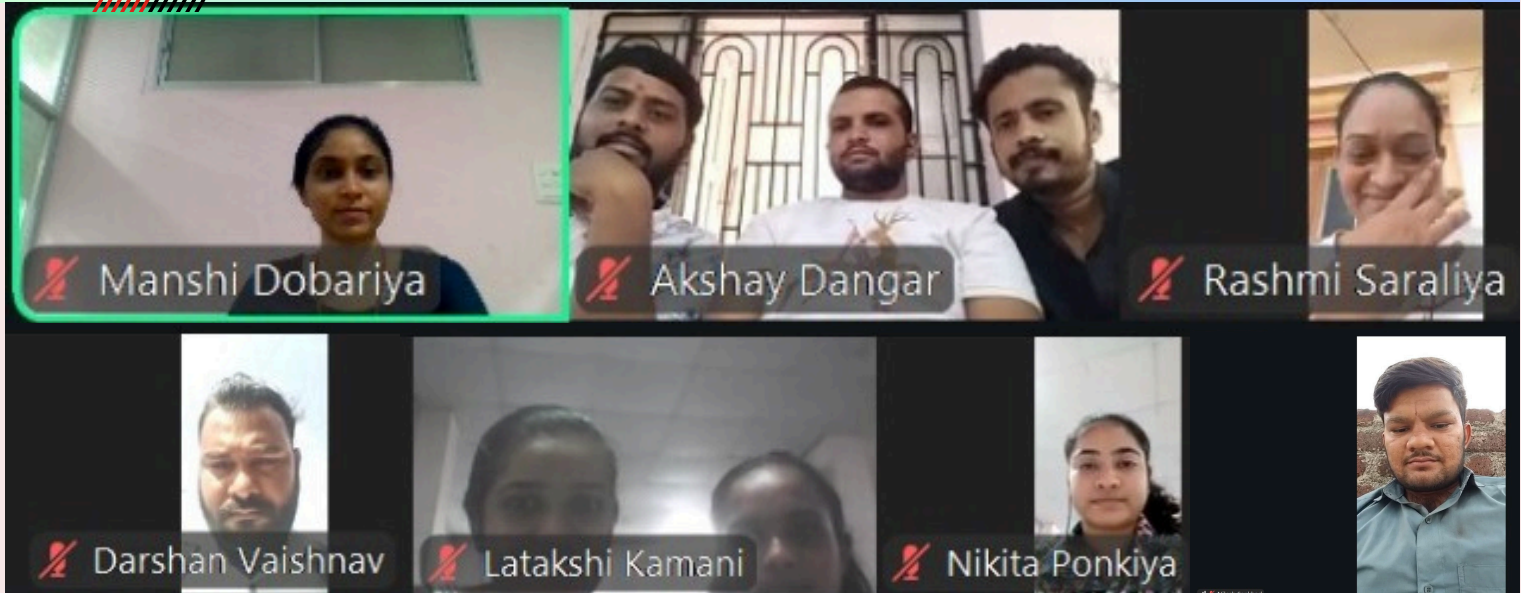

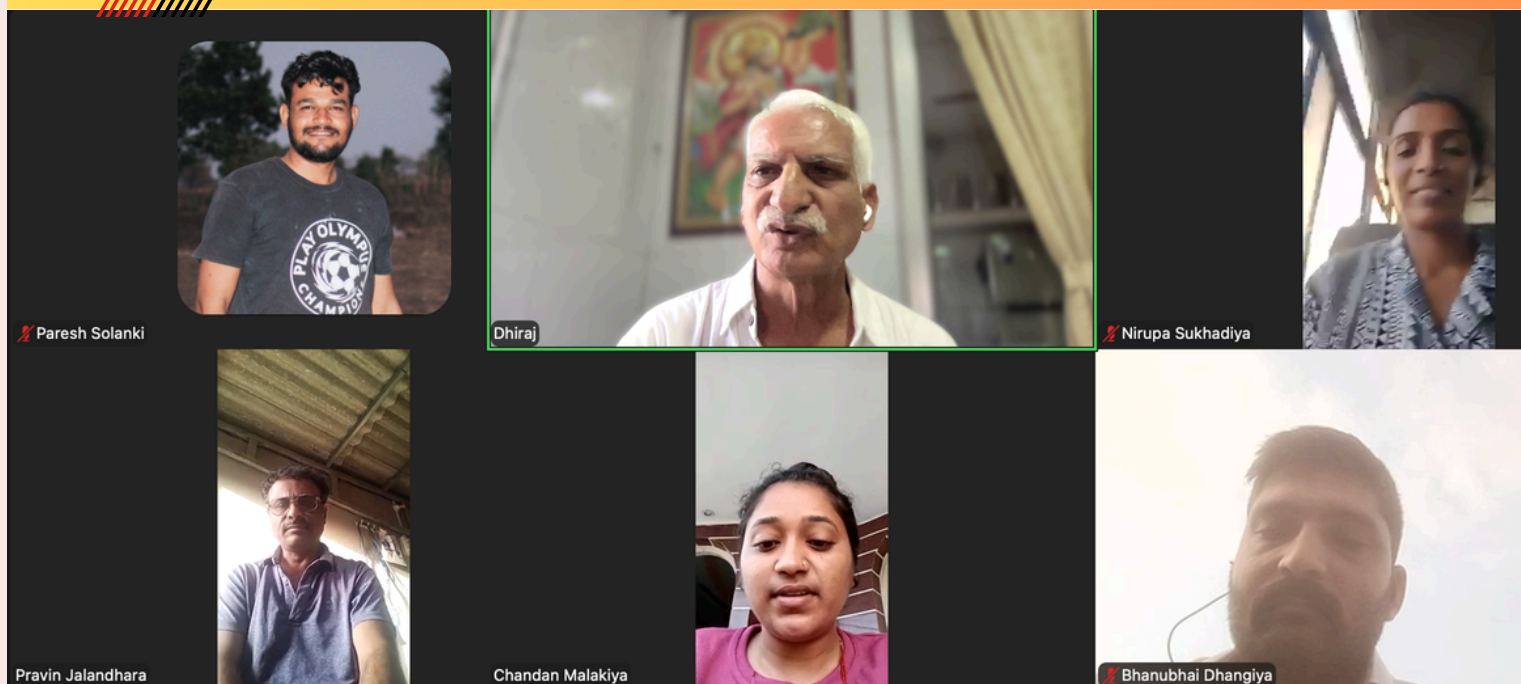


Reading Session

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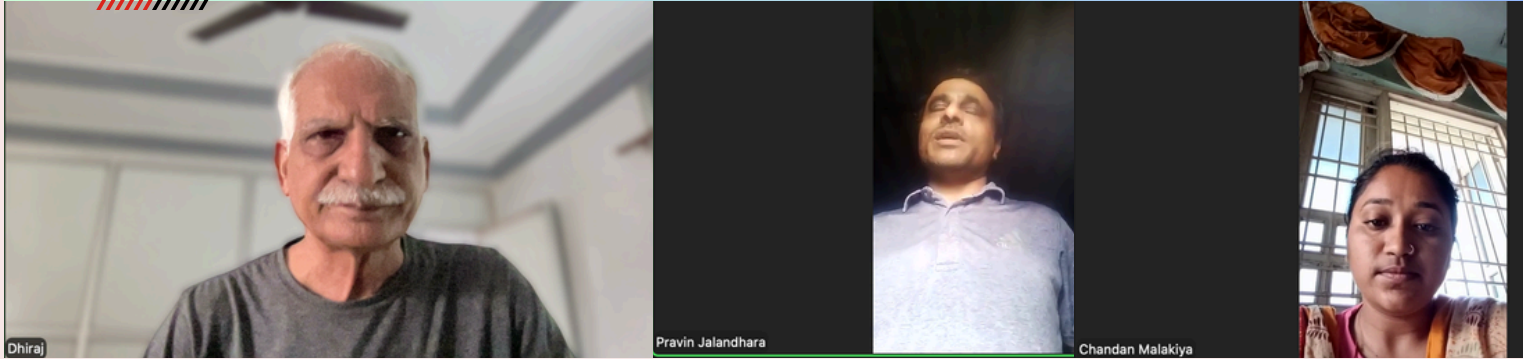
