This organization was established in 1993 by the collective efforts of a social worker Mr. Nayan Gandhi, Pushpa Patel, Sursh Gohil and Dhiraj Vagadia. At that time, it was decided to work according to the ideas and vision of the founders for the purpose of the improvement in health and education services of Amreli district. As per it organisation started its work of Primary education and Reproductive and Child Health program. We have been discussed to join livelihood program for women after seven year of establishment and started vocational training for women. Organization also included activities like construction of houses for Agariya who are living on costal area, renovation of historical places and educational researches. Now as per our huge experience, organization has started activities of natural resource management, formation of SHGs for self-employment and skill development trainings. Our team has joined with capacity building activity of "Gram Sanjivani Samiti" in Khambha, Dhari and Amreli blocks of Amreli districts also we could encourage farmers of Jafrabad block for formation of their own company.

We are working on the issues like Health, Education and Women empowerment, Self Help Groups, Agriculture and Environment. Especially our focus is to provide equal chances of business, education and health to youth of unorganized sector, women, children and economically deprived community. Organisation arrange training program for community to encourage and develop independent business. We are also joined with activities like natural resources management and agriculture. Our main strength lies in our experienced team thus we can implement our program successfully from grassroots level.

સંસ્થાની શરૂઆત ૧૯૯૩માં સામાજિક કાર્યકરો શ્રી નયન ગાંધી, શ્રી પુષ્પા પટેલ, શ્રી સુરેશ ગોહિલ અને શ્રી ધીરજ વાગડીયાના સંયુક્ત પ્રયાસોથી થઈ. શરૂઆતમાં એમ નક્કી કરવામાં આવ્યું કે સંસ્થાના સ્થાપકોના વિચારો અને વિઝન પ્રમાણે અમરેલી જિલ્લાની શિક્ષણ અને આરોગ્યની સેવાઓના સુધારા માટે કામ કરવું. તે પ્રમાણે સંસ્થાએ પ્રાથમિક શિક્ષણ અને પ્રજનન તેમજ બાળ આરોગ્ય કાર્યક્રમથી શરૂઆત કરેલ. સ્થાપનાના સાત વર્ષ બાદ મહિલાઓ માટે આજીવિકાના કાર્યક્રમને જોડવાની ચર્ચા થઈ અને મહિલાઓ માટે વ્યવસાયિક તાલીમોની શરૂઆત કરી. સંસ્થાએ અગરિયાઓ કે જેઓ સમુદ્રની આસપાસના વિસ્તારમાં રહે છે તેમના માટે આવાસો બાંધવાનું, ઐતિહાસિક સ્મારકોના પુનરોત્થાનનું તેમજ શૈક્ષણિક સંશોધનોની કામગીરીને પણ જોડવામાં આવી. હવે બહોળા અનુભવથી સંસ્થાએ કુદરતી સંસાધન વ્યવસ્થાપન, સ્વ સહાય જૂથોની અને કૌશલ્ય વિકાસ તાલીમોની પ્રવૃત્તિઓ શરૂ કરી. સંસ્થાની ટીમ ગ્રામ સંજીવની સમિતિઓની ક્ષમતા વર્ધન પ્રવૃત્તિમાં ખાંભા, ધારી અને અમરેલી તાલુકામાં જોડાઈ. જાફરાબાદ તાલુકાના ખેડૂતોને પ્રોત્સાહિત કરી ખેડૂતોએ પોતાની કંપની બનાવી.

To make understand boys about gender, organisation did a piloting project for gender education in two villages Chital and Vandaliya which contain 15 sessions and covered 100 youth with educational support of Equal Community Foundation.

Various projects run in organisation with financial support of any agencies have exact time limit. But after experience we know that if some programs like Health, awareness, education run continuously by staff of organisation may get results. So organisation is thinking about developing promotion of fellowship model. In which organisation promotes some youth who are enthusiast, have spirit of service and eagerness to learn something by providing incentive amount. Organisation has design to run fellowship model and will provide training related to subject to volunteer.

Staff training (Skill Development)

જેન્ડર એજ્યુકેશન

છોકરાઓમાં જેન્ડરની (લીંગભેદ) સમજ ઉભી થાય તે માટે સંસ્થા દ્વારા ઈકવલ કોમ્યુનીટી ફાઉન્ડેશનનાં (ECF) શૈક્ષણિક સહયોગથી વર્ષ દરમ્યાન ચિતલ અને વાંડળીયા ખાતે ૧૦૦ યુવાનો સાથે ૧૫ સેશન દ્વારા જેન્ડર એજ્યુકેશન અંગેની ચકાસણી આ પાયલોટીંગથી કરવામાં આવી.

એજ્યુકેશન સપોર્ટ પ્રોગ્રામ

સંસ્થા દ્વારા ચાલતાં વિવિધ કાર્યક્રમો નાણાકીય રીતે સહયોગી સંસ્થાઓ માટે ચોક્કસ સમય મર્યાદા માટેનાં હોય છે. પરંતુ અનુભવે જાણવા મળ્યું કે અમુક કાર્યક્રમો જેવા કે આરોગ્ય, જાગૃતિ, શિક્ષણ જેવા કાર્યક્રમો સતત સંસ્થાના કાર્યકરો મારફત ચાલે તો જ તેનું પરિણામ મળ્યા કરે આ માટે સંસ્થા ફેલોશીપ પ્રમોશન વિકસીત કરવા વિચારણા કરે છે. જેમાં સ્થાનિક કક્ષાએ કાર્યક્રમ સંબંધિત ઉત્સાહિત, સેવાની ભાવનાં અને તે પોતે પણ કંઈક શીખવાની ઘગશ ધરાવતાં વ્યક્તિઓને પ્રોત્સાહક રકમ સાથે પ્રોત્સાહિત કરવા પડે. આ માટે આવા સ્વયંસેવકોને વિષયને લગતી તાલીમ સંસ્થા આગામી સમયમાં આપી ફેલોશીપ શરૂ કરવા અંગેની ડીઝાઈન તૈયાર કરેલ છે.

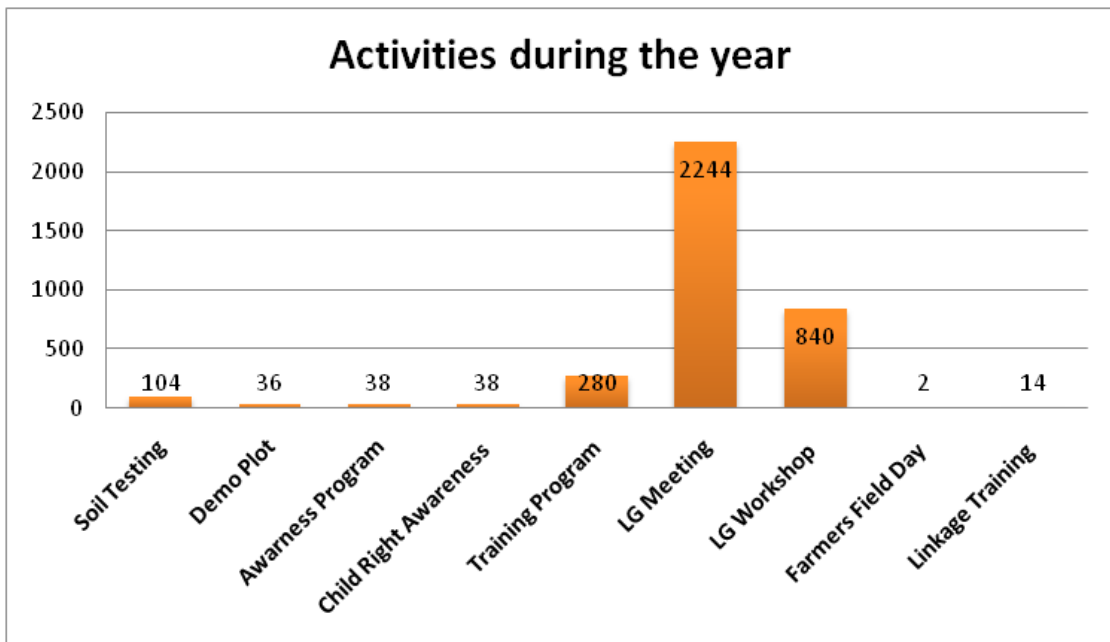

I am Talaviya Sureshbhai Manjibhai. I live in Pir Khijadiya village of Amreli district. I belongs to farmer family. As we see Amreli is leading district in cotton production. Due to lack of irrigation system in the area, most of farmers are dependent on rain water. Generally we are growing cotton, groundnut, sesame and black gram, green gram and maize as intercrop.

I am owner of 8 acres of fertile black soil. Before I have growing cotton as per traditional knowledge and the distance between two rows is 60 inches. But after joining BCI program and getting guidance from FF, this year I have planted cotton with 30*10 in 4 acres of area. Thus, the number of plant increases and also ratio of production will increase.

I have shown black gram, green gram and maize as intercrop in remaining 4 acres of land. I know the benefit of this scientific farming because there are two advantage of intercrop sowing, one is moisture of soil remain and second is if cotton crop ruined then intercrop will give benefit to me.

Before I am giving irrigation to each row but after guidance of the BCI Project, now it is given one by one. Due to this we have found benefit in diseases and decrease the cost of irrigation and saving the water.

Before Joining in this project I don't have system of writing the cost for each item, so I cannot calculate the expense and income. But now I have filled the FFB and have accurate data of expense. I have got guidance that how to get good production in less expenses and importance to save precious resources like water and how to balance environment through BCI program.
